The Gem City Practical Shooters are heating it up on the range! **Saturday, April 3rd** will begin our summer schedule, but being Easter we will not shoot on Sunday the 4th. After April, we will shoot on weekends that include the first Sunday of each month. Weather permitting, all the stages will be set up outside. We will be needing help setting up and tearing down matches so your help will be greatly appreciated; please contact Jim Johnson. Setup is on Saturday starting at 7AM so that we can get the first squad started by 9:30AM. Anyone assisting with setup and tear down will receive match credits.

So far this year we have had a terrific turnout and I hope the spring and summer weather will bring more of you out to try your hand at Practical Shooting. The shooting will be even more exciting now that we can go outdoors and spread out. Online squading has been working well and will continue for the outdoor matches with the exceptions of squading times. We will be shooting Saturday: 9:30, 4 squads and 12:30, 4 squads and on Sunday: 8:30, 4 squads and 12:00, 4 squads. This will be a shotgun start, as this format works well

If you are interested in coming out to shoot, all you need to do is show up! I will make sure you have all the info you need before you start, including a safety briefing as well as addressing equipment concerns. APRIL SHOWERS BRINGS OUT THE HIGH POWER RIFLE SHOOTERS. It wouldn't be any fun if the always warm and dry. As in the past the goal of the club is to attract new shooters to the sport. Everybody is welcome to come out and watch or try your hand. Don't think that you have to shoot fantastic scores or have the best equipment to have fun. If you don't have a rifle, the Club has several that are available. Also, for the promotion of the sport some of the past and present rifle team members have been working with the Junior Rifle Team to help get them interested in shooting high power rifle competition.

Special Note: CMP and NRA have approved the use of scoped AR-15 rifles to be shot in the National Match Course of fire. Check the CMP Rules for power of scope and weight of rifle.

Our season will start **April 11th** with our annual range maintenance the work party will begin at 9am. And will end when the work is completed. Our first match of the season will be on **April 25th**. Sign-in will begin at 7:30 AM and the first relay will start at 8AM. The second relay will begin about 10AM after the completion of the first relay and the third will begin at noon.

Course of fire will be:

- 3 sighting shots any position in 3 minutes
- 10 shots off hand slow fire in 10 minutes
- 10 shots rapid fire from sitting or kneeling in 60 seconds
- 10 shots rapid fire prone in 70 seconds
- 20 shots slow fire prone in 20 minutes

John C Garand and Springfield matches are shot in conjunction with the National Match Course. F Class Centerfire and Rimfire are shot from sand bags and are both 30-shot matches.

Trap shooting is slated to start on May 3rd this year. As we did last year, we will be mindful of social distancing and mask wearing to help prevent the spread of the Covid 19 virus. Hand sanitizer will be available on the range. As in the past couple years, the trap program will once again be administered "by committee" consisting of Joe Lander, Rick Bush and me.

Anyone interested in getting involved in trap shooting need only show up on a Monday afternoon. Sign up begins at 4:00 PM and we will continue to shoot as long as there are shooters present. The season runs from early May until the last Monday of October.

The cost remains unchanged at \$4.00 per round for members, \$5.00 for non-members.

We would like to encourage everyone who has an interest to bring young shooters to experience trap shooting. We are working to get young people involved in our sport. Also, if there is an organization such as a school or church that would like to form a "pick-up" trap team, the club has shotguns available for use, both 12 and 20 gauge. Shooters would have to supply or purchase their own shells.
